

Get a jump start on your college education this summer!

NOVA is offering select college courses free to Northern Virginia public, private, and home school graduating seniors thinking of attending NOVA this fall. Online summer sessions begin on May 31 and end on August 8, 2022.

by 5 p.m. April 29, 2022*

What you need to know about JumpStart2NOVA:

- JumpStart2NOVA courses are tuition free!
- Textbook and other course material purchases may be required.
- You may take one 3-credit course plus our one-credit College Success Skills course.
- A current high school transcript is required to complete your JumpStart2NOVA application
- JumpStart2NOVA courses are designed to fulfill NOVA degree requirements and transfer to other colleges and universities.
- You are enrolling in an online course. All class meetings and course content will be delivered in a virtual environment.

Who is eligible?

Current high school and homeschool seniors who will graduate in spring 2022, live in Arlington, Alexandria, Falls Church City, Fairfax City, Fairfax County, Loudoun County, Manassas City, Manassas Park City or Prince William County and are thinking of coming to NOVA in the fall. Applicants must demonstrate proof of college readiness and be in good academic standing at NOVA.

How do I apply to JumpStart2NOVA?

STEP 1: Apply to NOVA. If you are already a NOVA student, locate your EMPLID, username and password and proceed to step 2.

STEP 2: Complete the Registration Request. Go to nvcc.dualenroll.com. First time users must create an account using your personal email address and a new username and password. Returning users log into your existing nvcc.dualenroll.com account. Upload a current high school transcript and any additional qualifying score reports. Select JumpStart2NOVA 2022 as your term. Pick one course and add SDV 100 if you wish.

STEP 3: Check your email for updates on your JumpStart2NOVA application.

We will send you email updates as we process your application. Timely response is required. All steps and necessary documents must be submitted on or before **April 29, 2022.**
